In the weeks just before the festive period, our team had conducted multiple sessions in each partner country to test the onboarding methodology developed in Fly2Work Handbook. Here we present a more detailed summary.

The piloting session in Cagliari, Italy, was conducted with 14 young volunteers from Sardinia and the rest of Europe who took part in the European Solidarity Corps at TDM 2000. This session was invaluable to identify and evaluate the topics that the volunteers considered the most important for the onboarding process in the context where the voluntary service was short but intense and the cooperation with the team was crucial.





In France, the piloting session was conducted with two new employees of Pistes-Solidaires and a volunteer of Civic Service who all joined the team recently. They tested the practical approaches proposed in the Handbook, and all three highlighted their usefulness as it helped them initiate a conversation with colleagues and facilitate their integration into the workplace.
